HOT AIR BALLOONING



*Hot air balloon photography can be rewarding, both spiritually and professionally. There are no windows on a balloon, giving you the opportunity to take photographs in all 360 degrees. Here are a few tips that will help you get the most out of your aerial photography experience.*

*Tip #1- Bring an Appropriate Zoom Lens  
Bring your wide-angle lens also, so you can take more sweeping photos of your surroundings.*

*Tip #2- Avoid Blur and Shake  
There are perils of aerial photography: it is often very difficult to avoid unwanted blurring or vibration effects when taking pictures from the air.*

*Tip #3- Try Panoramic Photography  
A balloon is a great platform for panoramic photography. With a wide-angle setup, take several shots to record a 360 degree perspective, and find a photo stitching program to combine your pictures into a panoramic image.*

*Tip #4- Don't Forget the Balloons  
If you are flying in formation, be sure to take photos of other balloons silhouetted against the sky or the landscape.*

*Tip #5- Have Fun  
Enjoy yourself. Don't spend all your time meddling with your camera. Ballooning is a unique and serene experience, and you will be certain to remember your time ballooning for the rest of your life.*

*The spectacle that unfurls before you will remain engraved in your memory for ever. During the flight the pilot is in permanent contact with the ground crew.*

*The ground crew will be there to greet you at the landing for the traditional "toast des aéronautes" a convivial celebration in the Swiss countryside, before escorting you back to the departure point*
